  - And anyone that is interested in these programs

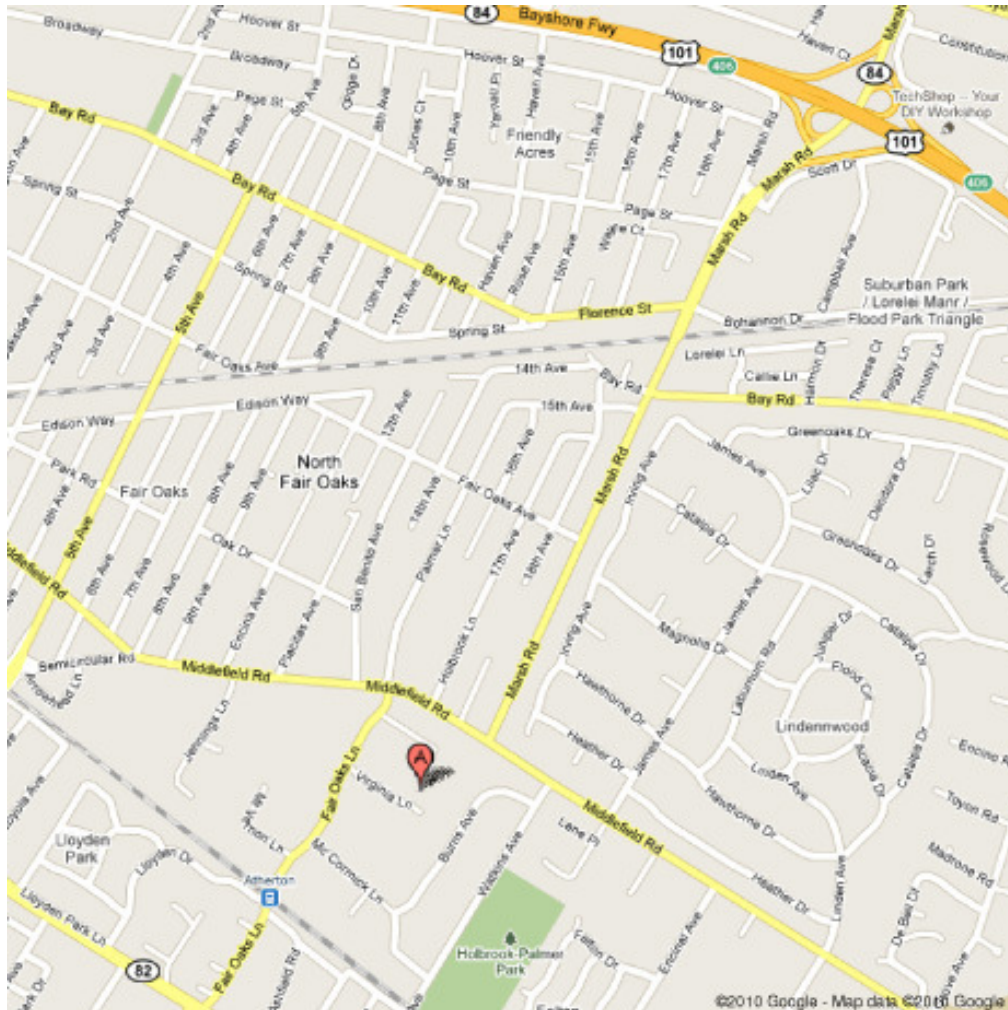
**What:** A bring-yourself-only get-together potluck to meet, greet, and exchange stories with fellow Rotary Foundation Alumni
